Ogisu Ravine and Campsite
4km length Ogisu Ravine Surrounded by Suzuka Mountains has Byobu Gorge eroded by streams. Ogisu Campsite is surrounded by greenery and clean stream. You can enjoy cool wind the ravine and some camping life in summer.

Tokai Nature Trail
This trail has 1,697km length from Tokyo to Osaka. In Suzuka, the walk goes through from the Tsubaki Shrine to the Ogisu Ravine along the Suzuka Mountains. You can enjoy the nature throughout the year.

This park was constructed in memory of the 100th anniversary of the Meiji Era. In the park, there are a lawn plaza, a multi-purpose area and a camp site, etc. Seasonal flowers bloom and many visitors enjoy coming here.

Ryoko-ji Temple
This is a Zen temple built in 1423 and is famous for "Kambo's lying Shakyamuni, Buddha". A picture of Nirvana is exhibited at a spring festival.

Inou Shrine and its Purple Azalea
Inou shrine has a long history and is dedicated to the god of eating and drinking business and its prosperity. You can see over 5,000 purple azalea trees blossom in spring and "Nanashima-ike ponds" is famous as an ancient style garden.

Koyasu-Kannon-ji Temple and Fudan-zakura Cherry Trees
The temple is reputed for miraculous virtue when women have a child and bear it. The cherry tree has been said to have blossoms through the year. Nio-mon (Two Deva Kings Gate) and a dedicatory bronze lantern are designated as Mie Prefecture cultural assets.

Memorial Hall of Kodaiyu Daikokuuya
Many items related to Kodaiyu Daikokuuya who introduced Russian culture to Japan for the first time are displayed here. Kodaiyu and his staff members were set adrift in a storm on the way to Edo on a ship. The ship landed on one of the Russian Aleutian Islands. During his nine and half-year stay in Russia, he met with the Russian Empress. Finally he returned back to Japan with much information on Russia.

Kouzei-ji Temple (Daruma-ji Temple)
On February 11 every year, people's wishes open the eyes of the Daruma figure; a grand memorial service is then held on October 5 for the Daruma, which has fulfilled those wishes, to vanish. The "fire of fulfilling wishes" which is lit at that time is said to bring good fortune.

Memorial Hall of Nobutsuna Sasaki
Nobutsuna Sasaki, born in Ishiyakushi town, is one of the most famous scholars of classical Japanese studies in Japan. Memorial Hall displays many items related to him, such as his works, desks, glasses and so on.

Sea Eel of Suzuka Ise Wakamatsu
The sea eel of Ise Bay, particularly the "sea eel of Ise Wakamatsu", is generally fish for using a method called "basket fishing", it is characterized by its freshness, and is widely known both in and outside the prefecture.

歴史・史跡 History & Historic sites

伊奈富神社

Tsubaki Shrine
The Tsubaki Shrine, the head shrine of the Saruhata Ohmikami, is located at the foot of Suzuka Mountains (Nyodogatake) and is famous for its Japanese garden and a tea-ceremony house.

Torin-ji Temple
The temple is built in 1181, located at the foot of the Suzuka Mountains that is 200m above sea level. You can enjoy a panoramic view of Ise Bay, Shima Peninsula and Chita Peninsula there.

府南寺金剛力士像

The pair statues of Kongorikishi (Fierce Guardian God) of Funan-ji Temple
This work is said have been created in the Kamakura Period. The height of the statues are 2.12m, and their eyes are wooden mosaic work; one statue has an open mouth, holding a stick spear, while the other has a closed mouth, holding a treasure stick. Both statues are true to nature and have features reminiscent of the Kamakura Period. The statues have been designated as important cultural properties by the government.

Tojin Odori (Korean Dance) at the Gozu Ten-no Shrine
Wearing strange looking masks from China, people jump and dance to flutes, drums and gongs. This is performed in the unique and mysterious atmosphere which is mixed with the Japanese Shinto and the Korean music.

Great Camphor Tree of Nago
This is a huge tree in Nagara District that has been nominated as a prefectural natural monument. Daruma Dera (Daruma Temple) It is said that, once upon a time, the tree was worshiped as a god's tree, and at its foot there was a shrine for large trees.

鈴鹿のかぶせ茶
1000年の伝と伝統で誇る鈴鹿のお茶。試行錯誤を繰り返した先人たちの努力が功を奏し、県内外の産地となり現在栽培されている品種は「やまとせ」が主流。鈴鹿をはじめ、県内のお茶は、茶の上に覆いかぶさせる「かぶせ茶」に特色があり、上質で香味ある茶として広く愛好されています。

伊勢形紙
The tea production in Suzuka has a 1,000 year history. By the effort of our predecessors, the production amount is ranked first in Mie prefecture. "Yabukita" tea is the main brand name of Suzuka.

鈴鹿市の発祥、延喜年間(798年頃)ともいわれ、鈴鹿の山々に産した肥松を焚いて墨を採り作つて伝えられてます。墨は、永年間重ねられた経験と勘能によって作られました。昭和15年10月16日に、伝統的工芸品の指定を受けたの芳香、優美、墨華麗な鈴鹿墨は、東京・中野をはじめ日本各地に出售されています。

鈴鹿抹茶
鈴鹿市産の茶葉を100%使用して製造した抹茶です。細かい粒度と強い旨味成分を生かして、大根のハントケーといったスイーツはもちろんのこと、蕪や「パンなど」(ラエティー)に富んだ商品を開発され、販売されています。

Suzuka Matcha (Pondered green tea)
This matcha is made using only tea leaves produced in Suzuka City. It was processed into sweets etc, and sells.
